

Acknowledgement Protocol

We emphasize acknowledgment protocol because we want to make sure there is funding in the future for projects like yours. Increased public awareness of the funding RICH provides to quality humanities programs such as yours helps to ensure that Congress will continue to support funding for NEH and the state affiliates.

You should use the RICH logo on all project materials and all project publicity (logo sheet enclosed; electronic files available upon request). With the logo, we expect the following language will be used on all project materials and all project publicity: “(Project Title) is made possible through major funding support from the Rhode Island Council for the Humanities, an independent state affiliate of the National Endowment for the Humanities.” You should also announce this before specific events that received RICH funding support.

We must also ask that you include the following disclaimer on all printed materials related to your project, “Any views, findings, conclusions, or recommendations expressed in this (project) (publication) (program) (exhibition) (website etc.) do not necessarily represent those of the National Endowment for the Humanities.”
